As of September 30, 2022, the Fund's aggregate NAV was \$3,162.0 million, the fair value of its investment portfolio was \$4,594.2 million and it had principal debt outstanding of \$1,439.6 million, resulting in a debt-to-equity ratio of approximately 0.46 times.

The Fund is currently publicly offering on a continuous basis up to \$4.0 billion in Shares (the 'Offering').
